ORDER

For the reasons stated in the attached Memorandum Opinion it is this 28th day of August, 2009 by the Circuit Court for Baltimore City,

ORDERED that Defendant Scott W. Rothstein’s Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Personal Jurisdiction (Docket No. 62) and Defendant Rothstein Rosenfeldt Adler P.A.’s Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Personal Jurisdiction (Docket No. 63) are GRANTED in part and DENIED in part and it is further

ORDERED that Plaintiffs may serve jurisdictional discovery consistent with the Memorandum Opinion on or before September 15, 2009. Service shall be by hand or electronic delivery. Defendants Scott W. Rothstein’ and Rothstein Rosenfeldt Adler P.A.’s shall respond to all written discovery no later than 15 days from the date of service, and shall file any objections to such discovery no later than five calendar days from the date of service. Responses and any objections shall be served by hand or electronically. All jurisdictional discovery shall be completed no later than October 15, 2009.

Plaintiffs shall file any Supplemental Memorandum in support of general jurisdiction no later than November 2, 2009 and Defendants Scott W. Rothstein’ and Rothstein Rosenfeldt Adler P.A. shall file any response no later than November 16, 2009 and a hearing will be held on November 24, 2009 at 9:30 a.m.
