MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

Before the Court are the Defendant’s Demand For a Bill of Particulars, the State’s Answer to the Defendant’s Demand For a Bill of Particulars, and the Defendant’s Exceptions to the State’s Answer to the Defendant’s Demand for a Bill of Particulars. A hearing on these matters was held before the Court on March 26, 2009.

After a review of the matter, the Court concludes that the exceptions need not be granted.
